

SAFETY PROTOCOLS

Battery Charging

- No charging of personal electronics in chalets when unoccupied
- Staff will unplug any devices they find plugged in when servicing your chalet
- All charging stations will be unplugged when guests go to bed

Smoke Detectors

All devices are serviced every six months

- Test power source
- Replace batteries (for battery operated units)
- Test smoke sensors using canned smoke or smoke matches

Chalet Orientations

- A staff member will show you to your chalet and provide an orientation including:
 - Showing the main escape route and explain how to reach the Assembly Area
 - Showing where the nearest fire extinguisher is and instructions on how to use it
 - When the Welcome Briefing will be held
- The safety systems presented will be reviewed again in the Welcome Briefing.

Smoking

- Is only allowed in designated area
- Smoking Area: TBD

Night Staff Accessibility

- The lodge has staff staff living on property that are available to assist guests in emergencies after hours.
- The Welcome and Safety Briefing will instruct guests how to contact staff after hours, after everyone has gone to bed.

Assembly Area

- Located at the Hill Tribe Fire Camp (in front of your chalet)
- If alarm sounds Do NOT return to your chalet.

Tell one of the staff immediately.

Actions To Take Upon Hearing the General Alarm Signal:


- Proceed directly to Muster Station #1
